

Policy Regarding Access to EHO's Generic Drug Pricing List

Policy Statement: This policy mandates that EHO shall ensure that its comprehensive list of all drugs subject to generic drug pricing is readily accessible to contracted pharmacies through a secure section of the EHO's web portal.

Purpose: This policy aims to:

- Enhance transparency in generic drug pricing.
- Provide contracted pharmacies with timely and accurate information. Facilitate better understanding of reimbursement rates.
- Improve inventory management for pharmacies.
- Support pharmacies in providing accurate pricing information to patients.

Scope: This policy applies to:

- All contracted pharmacies utilizing EHO's services.
- All drugs included in EHO's generic drug pricing programs.

Policy Details:

1. Secure Web Portal Access:

- EHO will maintain a comprehensive and up-to-date list of all drugs subject to generic drug pricing.
- This list will be accessible exclusively through a secure section of the EHO web portal.
- Access will be granted via each contracted pharmacy's unique and secure account.

2. Content of the Generic Drug Pricing List:

The list will include, at a minimum, the following information for each drug:

- Drug Name: Both brand and generic names
- Dosage Form and Strength
- National Drug Code (NDC)
- Applicable Generic Pricing Methodology (e.g., Maximum Allowable Cost (MAC), Wholesale Acquisition Cost (WAC) minus a percentage)
- Current Generic Price/Reimbursement Rate
- Effective Date of the Price
- Any relevant notes or limitations

3. Web Portal Functionality:

The EHO web portal will be designed to ensure:

- Secure login for authorized pharmacy personnel.
- Clear and intuitive navigation to the generic drug pricing list.
- Search and filtering capabilities (e.g., by drug name, NDC, dosage form, strength, effective date).
- Downloadable list in a commonly used format (e.g., CSV, Excel, PDF).

4. List Updates:

- EHO will establish a regular schedule for updating the generic drug pricing list. Updates will reflect changes in pricing, included drugs, or pricing methodologies.

- EHO will communicate updates to contracted pharmacies in a timely manner, either through the web portal or other communication channels.

5. Security and Confidentiality:

- Access to the generic drug pricing list will be restricted to authorized personnel of contracted pharmacies.
- EHO will implement security measures to protect the confidentiality and integrity of the information.

6. Pharmacy Support:

- EHO will provide adequate support and resources to contracted pharmacies.
- This support may include:
 - User guides
 - Frequently asked questions (FAQs)
 - Dedicated support contact information

Responsibilities:

● **EHO:**

- Develop, maintain, and update the generic drug pricing list.
- Ensure the list is accessible, secure, and user-friendly on the web portal.
- Communicate updates to contracted pharmacies.
- Provide support and resources related to the list.

● **Contracted Pharmacies:**

- Securely access and use the generic drug pricing list.
- Comply with contractual agreements and all applicable laws and regulations. **Review**

and Revision: This policy will be reviewed and updated periodically to ensure its continued relevance and effectiveness.
